

## TRANSPORTATION CAREERS

### IN SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH CENTRAL MINNESOTA



Transportation and warehousing is the second fastest growing industry in south central and southwest Minnesota, adding almost 1,000 jobs in the last decade (2007-2017). Increasing demand for workers and large numbers of openings has driven median wages higher than typical in the region, to \$17.72 per hour in 2017.



# FEMALES HOLD 1 OUT OF EVERY 5 JOBS IN TRANSPORTATION AND WAREHOUSING

The growing share of jobs held by women represent an increase of 28% from 2003 to 2017.
